This child has the following allergies:

I; Allergy to honey

Mild-moderate allergic reaction:

- Swollen lips, face or eyes
- Itchy/tingling mouth
- Hives or itchy skin rash
- Abdominal pain or vomiting
- Sudden change in behaviour

ACTION:

- Stay with the child, call for help if necessary
- Give antihistamine (if vomited, can repeat dose)
- Contact parent/carer



Watch for signs of ANAPHYLAXIS



(life-threatening allergic reaction):

ARWAY: Persistent cough, hoarse voice, difficulty, swallowing, swollen tongue

BREATHING: Difficult or noisy breathing, wheeze or persistent cough

CONSCIOUSNESS: Persistent dizziness/pale or floppy suddenly sleepy,

collapse, unconscious

If ANY ONE of these signs is present:

Additional Information:

- 1) Lie child flat. If breathing is difficult allow to sit
- 2) Dial 999 for an ambulance* and say ANAPHALAXIS ("ANA-FIL-AX-IS")
- 3) Stay with child, contact parent/carer
- 4) Commence CPR if there are no signs of life
- *You can dial 999 from any phone, even if there is no credit left on a mobile. Medical observation in hospital is recommended after anaphylaxis
