

Throughout this half term we will be linking our English work to our topic, "Our Planet". Children will complete a unit on a fiction genre of stories by the same author. They will listen to two stories by Benji Davies, Grandma Bird and The Storm Whale in preparation for writing their own story with a familiar character.

After that children will learn how to write persuasively in order to create simple posters to persuade someone to do something using some alliteration or word play. We will focus on persuading the reader to look after our planet.

Math/



This term, children focus on completing our unit of work on Multiplication and Division, then children will move onto fractions. In fractions children will learn to find and recognise a 1/2, 1/4 and 1/3 using concrete manipulatives and real-life representations. They will learn the difference between unit and non-unit fractions, equivalent fractions, find 3/4s and count fractions.

Science

In Science, we will continue our topic on Living things and their habitats. They will delve deeper into a range of habitats and microhabitats. Identifying and naming a variety of plants and animals in their habitats. Children will explore a range of microhabitats around the school grounds including the gardening club and forest school, searching for living things and discussing why these habitats are suited to the animals/minibeasts that live there. They will describe how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals, using the idea of a simple food chain.

Computing



In Computing children will be focusing on Information Technology. Children will type up their theme poems from their Literacy chance to shines and improve the presentation of a piece of work by changing the font size, colour and style. For example, using bond and large font to add enthesis to words.
