<i>R.E.</i>	During RE this term Base 6 will be exploring the question 'What can we learn from visiting sacred places?'. The children will be describing what is meant by 'sacred', comparing sacred places which are significant to religious believers. By the end of the topic the children will be able to explain the value of sacred places to religious believers.
PSHSE	In PSHE this term we are focusing on the topic 'Relationships'. We will gain an understanding of love and loss and the importance of making memories. We will discuss a positive friendship and learn how to know and show what makes a good friendship but also how to solve friendship problems when they occur.
Hirtory	During History this half-term we are going to be exploring Anglo-Saxons and Vikings, this is linked to our new topic 'Raiders and Traders'. In this unit, the children will be learning about the raids and invasions by Vikings in Anglo-Saxon Britain. The children will learn who the Vikings were as well as when and where they raided and settled.
MFL	As part of modern languages, we will be studying French. We will be learning about our school journey. The children we will learning the key vocabulary and phrases around the theme of school. The children will be able to say and write phrases about what's in their pencil cases and the subjects that they learn in school.
Art	This half term our artist of focus will be Jacob Lawrence 'Anglo-Saxon' and migration works, we will use his works to story colour and pattern through collage and painting. We will have the opportunity to study the artwork and practise using the art elements of colour and pattern before using this knowledge to practise painting and using collage to add these elements into our artwork.

Computing



This term Base 6 will be looking at Computer Science. This theme will involve Base 6 focusing on how to programme. The children will use Scratch with their computing lessons with our visitor from Amazing ICT. The children will use a range of programming throughout this term to showcase their learning



In Base 6, the children will continue to develop their skills with the Crossbar coaches. This half-term, the focus is outdoor adventure. The children will learn to orientate themselves with increasing confidence and accuracy around a short trail. The children will also be focusing on swimming. We will be learning to swim competently, confidently, and proficiently over 25 metres using a range of strokes effectively.

Additional Information

Please ensure children bring reading books and diaries into school every day. Children should be reading at least 5 times a week with the reading record signed by the person who listened to them read each time. Base 6 have PE on Monday and Thursday.
