




<p><b>English</b></p> 	<p><i>In English, we will be writing to entertain our audience. We will be exploring stories with historical settings, including a clear sequence of events. To start this topic of we will be discussing our main text, 'The Dragon's Hoard' and looking closely at stories with historical settings and their features to give us an understanding of what we need to include. The grammar that needs to be included in this narrative will be adjectives, adverbs, fronted adverbials, dialogue and paragraphs.</i></p>
<p><b>Maths</b></p> 	<p><i>This half term we will be exploring area of rectilinear shapes. We will then move on to length and perimeter, looking at various ways to measure (mm, cm, m, ml, l) and converting these measurements. Once we have finished this, we will then move on to fractions. We will start by recognising fractions and understanding how to count in fractions. We will explore equivalent fractions, fractions of an amount and how we add and subtract fractions.</i></p>
<p><b>Science</b></p> 	<p><i>In science we will be exploring the topic of 'electricity'. The children will be learning that some materials allow electricity through them, and others do not. We will be exploring the history of electricity and making/testing electrical circuits with a variety of components. They will use their knowledge of electricity to design and build a model of a burglar alarm for a house.</i></p>
