
 <p><b>English</b></p>	<p>Through our 'Stars and Stripes' topic, we will be using these as a stimulus to write stories with dramatic conventions by reading 'The Enchanted Moccasins'. We will also look at writing magazine articles linked to some of our amazing discovery of the USA. We will additionally explore biographies and autobiographies based on Sacagawea.</p> <p>As part of our whole class reading, we will be reading 'The Indian in the Cupboard' by Frank Oz.</p>
 <p><b>Maths:</b></p>	<p>In maths, we will be focusing on applying the fluency skills we have developed over the previous two terms to reasoning and problems solving. We will be looking a problem solving in the context of fractions, decimals and percentages and how we use the formal written methods for multiplication and division in context.</p> <p>After this, we will also be investigating problem solving using measurements and geometry through angles.</p>
 <p><b>Science</b></p>	<p>In science we will be investigating materials and their properties, For materials and their properties, we will build on our year 4 knowledge of solids, liquids and gases, by looking at mixtures and reactions. We will develop our skills of: researching, planning, grouping and classifying.</p>
 <p><b>Art and D.T.</b></p>	<p>As part of our theme 'Stars and Stripes, we will explore the amazing art of Georgia O'Keefe, Tarsila do Amaral and Navaho art. We will explore the art themes of shape and line through printing.</p> <p>As part of our art theme, we will learn how to continue to gain experience in overlaying colours. We will learn how to start to overlay prints with other media and use print as a starting point to embroidery.</p>
