







<p><b>R.E.</b></p> 	<p>During RE this term, Base 7 will focus on the question "Temptation: What can we learn from Muslims and Christians?" This will include retelling the story of Jesus' temptations, or another story of temptation, identifying sometimes when children are tempted to do things wrong and describe some things Muslims or Christians think are wrong, and some things they think are good. Also, they will make links between the teachings of one of the religions studied and the way people might choose to behave</p>
<p><b>PSHSE</b></p> 	<p>In PSHE this term, Base 7 are focusing on the topic Changing Me. During this topic they will recognise how bodies change as they grow up. They will discuss physical and emotional changes that can take place and strategies to help deal with these. Base 7 will identify changes that have been and may continue to be outside of their control and will learn to accept. Also, express any fears and concerns about changes that are outside of their control and know how to manage these feelings positively</p>
<p><b>P.E.</b></p> 	<p>This term, Base 7 will continue their PE skills with the Crossbar coaches and start swimming. They continue to develop basic pool safety skills and confidence in water, develop travel in vertical or horizontal position. Also, to develop push and glides, any kick action on front and back with or without support aids, to develop entry and exit, travel further, float and submerge. To develop balance, link activities and travel further on whole stroke. To show breath control. Introduction to deeper water. Treading water.</p>
<p><b>History</b></p> 	<p>This term Base 7 will focus on Ancient Greece. Base 7 will learn how Greece was divided into city states (polis) and two of the most well-known city states are Athens and Sparta. In Athens, Greek styles of art, architecture, philosophy, and theatre were developed and how these helped shape our modern society. Also, Base 7 will learn about the first Olympic games. Base 7, will identify this historical period on a chronological timeline and explore a range of sources to gather information about this period of history.</p>

<p><b>Art</b></p> 	<p>In Art this half term, Base 7 will be focusing on Pattern and Form. Base 7 will explore a range of great artists and develop their own artwork in their own sketch books. Throughout each session Base 7 will develop their art techniques in pattern and form using a range of art tools/skills. At the end of the topic, Base 7, will produce their own piece of artwork to demonstrate their new knowledge and skills.</p>
<p><b>Computing</b></p> 	<p>During Computing this half term, Base 7 will be focusing on Digital Literacy. Base 7, will know that data can be recording for different variables over a different time period, a digital device can be used to collect data automatically, a data logger collects data at a set point in time and a computer program can be used to sort and organise data. Base ,7 will also be working with professionals from AmazingICT to develop their computing skills further.</p>

### Additional Information

*Remember all children need their PE kits in school on Monday. They can remain in school over the week and will be sent home on Friday.
