

Through our 'World Beneath My Feet' topic, we will be using these as a stimulus to write poems with imagery. We will also look at writing non-chronological reports linked to biomes and climate zones so that we can write our own nonchronological reports. We will also explore newspaper reports linked to saving our planet.

As part of our whole class reading, we will be reading 'The Boreal Forest by L.E Carmichael.



In maths we will be ensuring our understanding of multiplication and division and calculation of all four operations is secure. We will look closely at fractions, mixed numbers, decimals and percentages and considering the relationships between them.

We will then move on to addition and subtraction of fractions, focusing on written calculation methods and solving problems using our reasoning skills.



In science we will be investigating Earth in Space as well as soils. For Earth in Space, we will be describing the relative motion of the Earth, the Moon and the Sun and state the difference between a sun, a planet and a moon. We will be able to explain night and day in terms of the rotation of the Earth, and investigate differences in the time of day and the length of day in different parts of the World



This will be a focus in the Spring second half term.
