



<p><b>R.E.</b></p> 	<p>We will be exploring: Expressing spiritual ideas and beliefs about God through the Arts. The focus is on engagement with Christian ideas explored through the arts.</p> <p>We will think about questions to do with the meaning, history and spirituality behind the works of art, drama, and music studied. Pupils are encouraged to consider what can be learned from these expressions of faith by referring to their own experiences, beliefs and values.</p>
<p><b>PSHE</b></p> 	<p>In PSHE we will be following the JIGSAW whole school scheme of work. The first unit of the Spring term is called: Dreams and Goals. Children will have opportunities to explore their own dreams and goals, and what a dream and goal means to them.</p> <p>In RSHE, we will be learning about the importance of respecting others, even when they are very different from them or make different choices or have different preferences or beliefs.</p>
<p><b>P.E.</b></p> 	<p>Children will develop games skills through focusing on gymnastics. We will start by learning how to use different balances, movements and jumps to create a performance. Everyone will learn how to control balances and movements whilst using a range of apparatus.</p>
<p><b>Geography</b></p> 	<p>As part of our 'World Beneath My Feet' theme, we will be exploring climate zones and biomes around the world. Everyone will explore each biome and recognise the flora and fauna that is particular to that biome.</p> <p>We will also explore ways to sustain our planet by thinking about recycling, reusing, and reducing.</p>

<p><b>Music</b></p> 	<p>Our music will be linked to a theme called 'Dancing in the Street'. In this unit, we will be comparing two songs in the same style, talking about what stands out musically in each of them, their similarities and differences. Everyone will listen carefully and respectfully to other people's thoughts about the music, using musical words. We will talk about the music and how it makes them feel as well as singing in unison and to sing backing vocals.</p>
<p><b>Computing</b></p> 	<p>In computing we will be developing our use of research techniques and using this to inform our work. We will create digital scrapbooks in order to store our findings for future projects. We will also consider the best way to present information digitally. We will ensure we have a good knowledge of e-safety and how to report concerns.</p>
<p><b>History</b></p> 	<p>This will be a focus in the next half-term.</p>
<p><b>MFL</b></p> 	<p>As part of modern languages, we will be continuing learning French. We will learn to talk about ways that we get to school and modes of transport. We will also learn about more about visiting theme parks in France. Our learning will mostly be through practical activities such as art, music, games and drama.</p>
