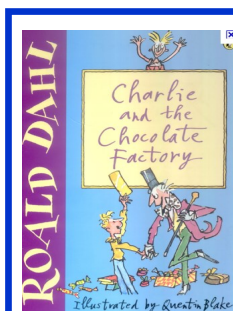

KEY STAGE 2 NEWS



This week Base 5 have been focusing on recipes from Charlie and the Chocolate Factory. They have written their own recipes for their own Willy Wonka creation. In Maths children have been recapping the column method for addition and subtraction in order to help them solve missing number problems. In science children have been learning about iron in food and tested whether this could make foods magnetic. Children have been learning the song food glorious food in music. In geography Base 5 have begun to understand where food comes from and how it get to their plates. In PE children have been improving their rounders and swimming skills and are looking forward to our sponsored swim.

Base 6 have enjoyed their music lesson this week. They have learnt all about the wood wind instruments. Children have also enjoyed learning about different mountains and writing information texts on their own chosen mountain. Children are enjoying their misty mountains theme and have made their own 3d mountains out of paper mache. In numeracy, children have been learning how to estimate and solve multi-step problems. Children are excited to return to swimming this week.

This week, in Base 7 children have been continuing to learn all about the black death! They have been researching what it was like to live in medieval England at the time of the black death and how it affected everyday life. In literacy children are writing journals, selecting a point of view to write them from. In maths Base 7 have been investigating shape, looking at how to calculate angles, perimeters and classify different triangles and polygons. In science children have been finding out all about herbs. They have observed, smelt and even tasted different herbs, working out why doctors in medieval England used them at attempted cures for the plague!

In maths Base 8 have used National Money week to focus on financial capability. The children have explored different jobs and the salaries associated and then calculated earnings from data about hours worked, price per hour and days or months worked per year. Children have also looked at budgeting and managing income so that it does not exceed expenditure. In literacy children have been working on narrative story linking their writing with their Love To Read book: Bill's New Frock. This week Base 8 have begun work on their end of year performance, casting the parts and beginning to learn some of the songs.
