KEY STAGE 2 NEWS




This week Base 5 have been continuing to look at the story the Giraffe the Pelly and me. They have written a character description, a story dilemma and a resolution. In Maths they have been using the column method for addition and subtraction for numbers up to 10,000. They choose questions that they would like to find out the answers to about Harris Hawks and used the laptops with partners to research and answer their questions. Base 5 have been looking at artwork by Megan Coyle and made animals collages in the same style. In science children have discovered different types of skeletons and why different animals have different skeletons.



This week in maths Base 6 have been developing their skills of estimation by rounding numbers to the nearest thousand. They have also been developing their skills in addition to use column methods to add two four digit numbers with regrouping. In literacy children have been developing their writing skills looking at setting descriptions. The children have been learning about personification and how to use it in their own writing. Children have written a description of a setting connected to our text Alice in Wonderland and then written a description of a setting from their own imagination. In PE Base 6 have been developing dribbling and passing skills in basketball.

In Base 7 this week, children have been writing their own persuasive leaflets for people to visit their very own theme park. They have looked at lots of different persuasive leaflets, getting lots of good ideas, before applying them to their own leaflet! In maths children have been challenging themselves through addition and subtraction. Base 7 have recapped on the column method for both addition and subtraction and used these methods to solve different problems. In science children have been finding out about the forces that effect the movement of a rollercoaster. They have found out the effect of friction, air resistance and gravity, even considering the effect of water resistance on the log flume. In art Base 7 have made their own theme park logos to accompany their leaflets.



This week in Base 8 children have been very busy writing narratives based on their Frozen Kingdom theme. Children have shown a really good understanding of how to structure a story and have included some fabulous language for description. In Maths children have been working on multiplication this week. They are applying their tables knowledge to problem solving and reasoning and using algorithms for long multiplication and for multiplying decimals. Their science work continues to focus on the animal life in the polar regions and how they have adapted over time to suit their habitat. In PE children are working on the skills of attacking and defending in basketball and netball style games.
