









<p>R.E.</p> 	<p>We will continue to explore the key question: "How do people express their spiritual ideas through the arts?" (Christianity) The unit allows pupils to engage with spiritual ideas through the arts. Pupils are enabled to think for themselves about questions to do with the meaning, history and spirituality behind the works of art, drama, and music studied.</p>
<p>PSHE</p> 	<p>In PSHE we will be following the JIGSAW whole school scheme of work. The unit for the second half of the Spring term is called: Healthy Me. Children will have opportunities to explore the importance of a healthy, balanced diet and exercise. They will also consider ways to combat stress and achieve mental well-being.</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>Children will continue develop games skills through focusing on gymnastics. We will start by learning how to use different balances, movements and jumps to create a performance. Everyone will learn how to control balances and movements whilst using a range of apparatus.</p>
<p>Geography</p> 	<p>Next terms focus</p>

<p>Music</p> 	<p>Our music will continue to be linked to a theme called 'Dancing in the Street'. In this unit, we will be comparing two songs in the same style, talking about what stands out musically in each of them, their similarities and differences. Everyone will listen carefully and respectfully to other people's thoughts about the music, using musical words. We will talk about the music and how it makes them feel as well as singing in unison and to sing backing vocals.</p>
<p>Computing</p> 	<p>In computing we will be developing knowledge of how networks and communication between different computer systems are set up. We will also consider the best way to present information digitally through different packages. We will ensure we have a good knowledge of e-safety and how to report concerns.</p>
<p>History</p> 	<p>We will be studying migration through history. We will be focusing the Migration of people from the Caribbean to the Uk following World War 2. We will be learning about why this migration was so important to the British Economy at the time following WW2 and the part the people played in rebuilding Britain.</p>
<p>MFL</p> 	<p>As part of modern languages, we will be continuing learning French. We will learn to talk about ways that we get to school and modes of transport. We will also learn about more about visiting theme parks in France. Our learning will mostly be through practical activities such as art, music, games and drama.</p>
