### KEY STAGE 1 NEWS



In Base 1 children have been doing some descriptive writing about characters from the story 'Harry and the dinosaurs go on holiday'. In their topic work they have been investigating, and designing different bird houses ready to make them next week. Children have also enjoyed learning about the Solar System. They learnt a new song about the planets!

This week Base 2 have been writing their information texts all about the seasons and children finally did our big write on this. Children have also been learning all about time and reading the times for o'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past.



This week in maths Base 3 have been doing lots of work around time. Children have been telling the time to half past, o'clock, quarter past and quarter to and they have been converting analogue times to digital times. In literacy children have been finishing their information text about the four seasons. The children have learned learning about them and have a good understanding of the difference between them all. In science Base 3 have designed and made some

This week Base 4 have been reading the story 'Stanley's Stick' in Literacy and children have written a character and setting description before planning their own story of Stanley's Stick. In maths children have been using their knowledge of the forwards jump method to solve missing box problems and two step word problems. In Science this week Base 4 carried out a heart rate investigation looking at the impact that different activities have on their heart rate. Children also had a visit from Hugh at simply music on Monday and continued to develop their knowledge of percussion instruments and notation.
