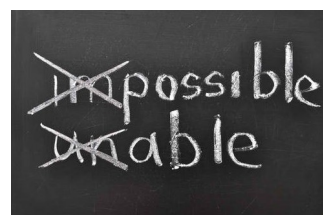

KEY STAGE I NEWS



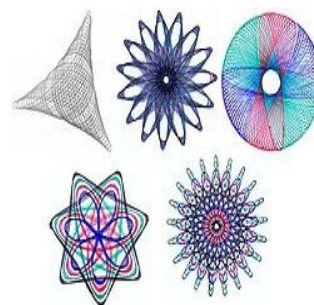
In Base 1 this week children have been writing instructions on how to make a strawberry smoothie. In maths they have been learning about time, and using the clocks to show the time. Children really enjoyed their traffic survey and looking at all the different vehicles. Base 1 also had a great first Sports day and enjoyed taking part in all activities.

Base 2 have worked really hard completing assessments this week. Children had fun during their sports day taking part in the events in the very hot very. Base 2 children have also been learning about growth mindset, undertaking different activities to help them understand the principle.



This week has been assessment week. Base 3 thoroughly enjoyed sports day on Tuesday and it was great to see them having so much fun. After sports day the children wrote a recount about it. The children have been thinking about and preparing themselves for our school trip to Dudley Zoo on Monday. They have to think of all the questions and information they would like to find out about whilst they are there.

This week Base 4 children took part in the Key Stage One sports day, they participated in the following races: egg and spoon race, running race and hoopla race. In Literacy this week children have been learning about persuasion and highlighting the features of a persuasive letter. In Maths children have been learning about capacity and have used capacity to solve mathematical problems, using methods such as, forwards jump and partitioning. Children have also been experimenting with a spiral graph in art.
