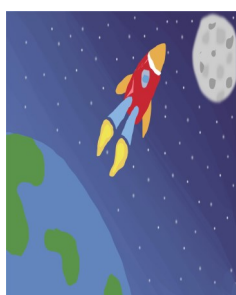

KEY STAGE I NEWS



This week in Base 1 children have been learning all about instructions; they had to follow instructions to learn how to wash their hands properly. For their Harvest festival assembly children have been learning about the country Latvia. Base 1 made their own Latvian flags and they have even made a delicious Latvian apple cake to donate for harvest.


Base 2 have been learning about Harvest celebrations around the world this week. In light of this, they looked at food from other countries such as Spain and made their very own tapas! Children will be donating this to the Harvest collection. In Maths Base 2 have been learning all about shapes and went on a shape hunt around the school. Miss Deakin-Mundy has been very forgetful this week, so in English the children have been writing instructions to help her complete different tasks such as making a jam sandwich.



In maths Base 3 have been solving a mixture of addition and subtraction problems. Children have been using number lines or the column method to help them solve these. In literacy children have been writing the beginning, middle and end to their story about the rocket which landed on the moon. Base 3 have used expanded noun phrases to make their writing more interesting. In topic children have been getting their food ready for the harvest assembly. In science children made some rockets!!!

This week base 4 have been learning how to use the column subtraction method by regrouping the ones, tens and hundreds. In literacy children have been looking at non-fiction text and making talk plans to follow when creating their own non-fiction booklet. In science children have carried out their planned investigation. In DT Base 4 have cooked a chow mein which they showed in today's harvest festival assembly.
